Parish Annual General Meeting – 28 June

With the recent government changes to requirements for the gathering of people, I am pleased to advise that there will be a limited number of spaces available for people to attend the 2020 Parish Annual General Meeting. The meeting is to be held on Sunday 28 June at 12 noon in the St James' Hall.

It will be held using the Zoom conferencing system, however it is also possible for a maximum of 20 people to attend in person. Parishioners wishing to attend either in person or on Zoom need to register online at www.sjks.org.au/agm-registration/ where they can also download the reports and nomination forms. Those without internet access will need to phone the Parish Office on 8227 1300.

Worship Arrangements at St James'

With a further easing of government restrictions from 1 July, we anticipate being able to accommodate more people in our services. As from 1 July, the following will apply:

Sunday:	8am - Holy Eucharist:	36 places available – entering from the North Porch.
	10am – Choral Eucharist:	84 places available – entering from the Tower entrance • This service is livestreamed
Mon - Fri:	8:30am – Morning Prayer:	Held using Zoom conferencing
	12:30pm – Holy Eucharist:	6 places available in the Chapel – entering from the North Porch
Wednesday:	6:15pm – Choral Evensong	84 places available – entering from the Tower entrance • This service is livestreamed

You will still need to register your attendance online at: <https://www.sjks.org.au/service-registration/> or telephone the Parish Office on 8227 1300. Once you have registered you can assume that there is a seat available for you in the service unless someone contacts you to advise otherwise.

Please note the following COVID-19 restrictions for attendance at worship:

- You must not attend the service if you feel unwell,
- You must adhere to physical distancing guidelines and sit in the church at those places marked by a green dot,
- Hand sanitiser is provided for use when arriving and leaving,
- Random temperature checks will be conducted when entering at the door, and
- Members of the congregation must not sing during the choral services because of the risk of spreading COVID-19 through proximity to other people.

Post-service refreshments will continue to remain on hold at this stage.
