Dear Parishioners,

In Advent we eagerly await the celebration of God's coming to live among us in the person of Jesus. This is a time of anticipation in which we look forward to that birth at one time that leads to continued rebirth, both in our hearts and in the corporate life of the people of God through history.

We happily note the further easing of COVID-19 controls. We are now benefitting from the infection management practices that were instituted earlier in the year, and that allows us to look forward to the celebration of Christmas in a more traditional way. Thanks be to God!

Latest COVID-19 Restrictions

The Archbishop has written to all parishes advising them of the new government guidelines that came into place on 7 December. In summary, they are:

- The 4 sqm rule has been replaced by the 2 sqm rule, which increases the capacity for church attendance, including weddings and funerals, to: 170 (Eucharistic services) and 180 (Non-Eucharistic services);
- Masks continue to be provided for people attending worship and who wish to use them;
- The Choir may be expanded in size and must be located at least 5 metres from the congregation;
- The congregation may sing the hymns quietly, and it is recommended that masks be worn when doing so;
- Recording of contact details, the time attending, the use of hand sanitiser, and cleaning of surfaces between services continues to be required.

- Thursday 24 December 6pm Christingle (In church and livestreamed)
 - 10:30pm Night Eucharist of the Nativity
- Friday 25 December: 8am & 10am Christmas Day Eucharist
